- Important Safety Issues & Concerns: Please help keep our students safe as they are arrive at and leave Repetto School each day. Lately, we have noticed several dangerous driving behaviors and even some near misses. Please be aware that we have asked the Monterey Park Police Department to increase their patrol of our school. Parents who drive dangerously may be subject to a citation/fine. Many cars are not stopping at the crosswalks to allow students to cross to and from school safely. (Remember that pedestrians always have the right of way at the crosswalk, even if there is no crossing guard present.) We also observed parents making dangerous U-turns and/or turns into the gate/parking lot/neighbors' driveways. Lastly, we would like to remind parents who use the valet drop-off lane to drive slowly through the valet area and to look both ways before merging back into traffic. We are always in need of additional parents to help with the valet lane in the morning. If you can help at least one morning a week, please provide your name and contact information to the office.
- Pon't Forget to Order a Yearbook: There are only two weeks left to order a 2013 yearbook. Yearbooks are only available by pre-sale, so make sure to purchase yours no later than March 8th. Extra order forms are available in the school office. March 8th is also the deadline to order and submit any dedication pages.
